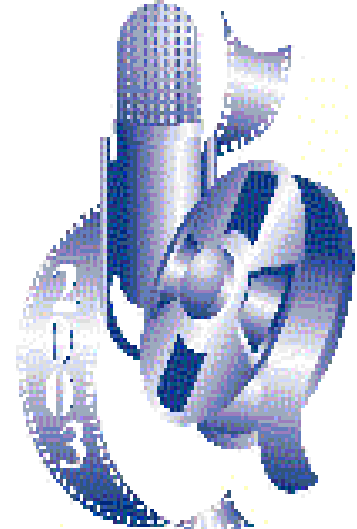


# **NASP's *Portraits of the Children: Culturally Competent Assessment* Wins a 2003 Communicators Awards Honorable Mention**

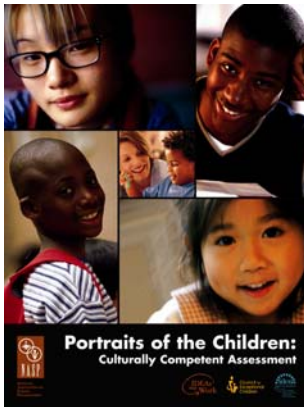
## **The Award**

*The Communicators Awards* is an independent award competition founded by communications professionals to recognize outstanding work in the communications field. *Portraits of the Children: Culturally Competent Assessment Video/CD-ROM* won an honorable mention for interactive media from the 2003 Communicator Awards Program. This award is in the multi-media category and was judged on production work done on the video as well as the design and print materials on the CD-ROM. The 2003 Communicators Award festival, now in its tenth year, received 2,867 entries from the U.S. and 11 other countries.



Entries are judged by communications professionals who look for individuals and companies whose talent exceeds a high standard of excellence and whose work serves as a benchmark for the industry. Judges evaluate the clarity, creativity and resourcefulness of each entry. They also consider the interaction between pictures, graphics and words. Judges try to look at the entry from the technical point of view of an experienced professional, and also from the viewpoint of the person who is the target of the material.
